

Alcohol Use Policy

This policy governs the use of alcohol at official Revolution Church events.

Official Policy

The serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages at official Revolution Church events is not permitted. This is to insure that we do not cause a brother or sister to stumble, and that we take all measures to provide a safe place to fellowship for people who may have issues with alcohol addiction.

Revolution Church Stance on use of Alcohol

At Revolution Church we believe in the freedom for people age 21 or older to responsibly use alcohol whenever they wish as long as it is not at an official event where we may not know who will show up. Know your audience – if you don't know who may show up, you have no idea if they struggle.

- 1 Corinthians 8:9 *“Be careful, however, that the exercise of your rights does not become a stumbling block to the weak.”*
- 1 Corinthians 10:23-24, 31 *“[23](#)“I have the right to do anything,” you say—but not everything is beneficial. “I have the right to do anything”—but not everything is constructive.[24](#)No one should seek their own good, but the good of others.”” [31](#)So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.”*
